### AGILE IS TRAPPED


A lot of organizations see Agile as something equivalent to teamlevel Scrum and leverage it mostly for the teams involved in execution – trapped at the work surface.

What we have in many organizations is Agile that's trapped in the execution space — over to the far right. And it's incapable of addressing the full range of problems and opportunities most companies are facing.


Agile trapped in execution just isn't Agile.
